Looking Forward

This is my last communication as Lay Director of the GAE4DG. I will continue on the Board for another year as the GAE Board Rep to the SWTC. It has been an honor and a blessing beyond measure to serve as your 4DG Lay Director. I ask that you now welcome the leadership for 2007-2008: Rev. Georgia Stone as Spiritual Director, Bud Broeker as Lay Director, Leslie Smith as Assistant Lay Director, Jack Foreman as the Board Member of Gathering Support, and Tonna Marcyes as Board Member for Walk Support. Wayne Roche will continue as Board Member for Member Services and Mike Rhodes will continue as Treasurer.

There are a couple of on-going items that I want to address in this, my last "missive." (One of my late dad's favorite words!) First, we are still preparing the new Emmaus trailer for Walk service this fall. Within the next couple of weeks we will post on the website (<u>www.austinemmaus.org</u>) a list of items needed for the trailer. If there is something you would like to provide, you will have the opportunity to do so. One of the key items needed is a set of 15 talk banners. If there are creative seamstresses out there who would like to help by making a banner or two (or three), please get in touch with me at <u>kathyshaw@swbell.net</u>

The second item is a mailing that will go to the entire GAE4DG database - all 5,900+ individuals currently listed! The purpose of this mailing is to rebuild the database with current information only on those individuals still in the area and still wanting to be active in Emmaus. The main use of this database is Walk team selection, and for that purpose, previous team service records need to be kept up-to-date. According to the Upper Room Guidelines, when we select a team for a Walk, we must select 6 individuals who have 0-1 team experience, 6 who have served on 2-3 teams, and 6 who have served on more than 3 teams. We also strive to select team members who are representative of the churches, ages and ethnicity found in our 4DG. Another use of the database is to track the service progress of those individuals who have indicated an interest in serving as a Walk Lay Director. Those individuals must complete seven Walk service areas before they can serve as LD, so it's very important that their service information is kept current.

In the mailing, you will also receive information on how to obtain the new team application form, how to complete it and where to return it. You will find that the new form is very thorough and detailed, but from the information you provide, we will be able to rebuild our database with accurate information. Even if you have submitted a team application in the past, you will need to re-submit a new form to stay in the new database.

Much is happening in our Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group - on-going projects and new leadership coming in. Please be in prayer that GAE4DG continues to serve God by equipping individuals to serve Him in our communities, in our churches and in Emmaus.

The Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group Board of Directors met on Monday, May 21st at Crestview UMC. In attendance were:

Kathy Shaw called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm and offered an opening prayer.

Minutes – A motion to approve the minutes from the April 2007 meeting was approved (Jim Anthony motion, Mike Rhodes second).

A motion to accept the treasurer's report was approved (Bud Broeker motion, Wayne Roche second)

Board Representative – Beth read a letter from Mike Cave, South Central Region Clergy Rep, International Emmaus Advisory Committee with a request from the representative of the Upper Room for Africa South, which includes South Africa, Ghana, and Zimbabwe. They are in deep financial trouble and Rev. Cave is asking all 4th Day Groups in the SWTx Community to hold special offerings at their next Gatherings, hoping for a minimum of \$150 from each 4th Day Group. A motion to send a donation of \$150 from the GEA4DG funds was approved (Beth Bible motion, Wayne Roche second). Another motion to hold a special offering at the June Gathering was also approved (Beth Bible motion, Nancy White second).

Lay Director – Kathy Shaw reported that we now have Lay Directors assigned for three of our 2008 Walks: March Men's Walk – Gene McConnell; September Women's Walk – Belinda Smith; and September Men's Walk – Randy Nettles. Kathy will try to get the SWTx Community to give us a later date than the current January date; if this is unsuccessful, she will be contacting additional potentials for the January Women's Walk.

Board Member/Member Services – Wayne Roche presented a first draft of the two-piece postcard that we intend to use to announce a new online application and "Call to Action" to rebuild our volunteer/team database. The postcard also features a list of upcoming Emmaus events and provides a feedback mechanism for those that would prefer to receive a hard copy of the application. It was also learned during the meeting that an application for non-profit mailing status was awarded to our group. Since this format of mailing does not meet the desires of the donor of the \$2500 designated gift for a mailing, the Board voted to return the donation and pay for the mailing from GAE4DG funds.

New Business – Jim Anthony relayed a request from Rev. Ann Beaty of Tarrytown UMC for the loan of 25 battery powered candles for use at a youth camp she is involved in. The Board agreed to this use of our candles.

There being no further new business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:35 PM, followed by a closing prayer by Beth Bible.
