The GAE4DG trailer is loaded and in place in time for Walk 1387 starting 6 September 2007. The nice folks at Highland Lakes have allowed us to keep it right behind their office – it would be hard to find a more convenient place.

Walk 1387 has "made" in that there are more than the minimum number of pilgrims signed up with three weeks to go! Candlelight is 7:30 PM on Saturday 8 September and closing is at 3:00 PM on Sunday 9 September at Highland Lakes Camp and Conference Center – y'all come, hear! Both candlelight and closing are in the conference center across from where the Miles auditorium was before it burned down. The conference center worked well for the last walk and is a lot less work than using the dining hall as we did for the first walk after the fire.

Is It Time?

The Great Reformer was clear that the purpose of gathering as Christians is a life-changing encounter with Christ so people leave worship different from when they came. (Daily worship was common then). Yet he also understood that merely attending worship guaranteed nothing. The Great Reformer was clear that the purpose of gathering as Christians is a life-changing encounter with Christ so people leave worship different from when they came. (Daily worship was common then). Yet he also understood that merely attending worship guaranteed nothing.

"People can go to church daily and come away the same as they went. For they think they need only listen at the time, without any thought of learning or remembering anything. Many a man listens to sermons for three or four years and does not retain enough to give a single answer concerning his faith -- as I experience daily. Enough has been written in books, yes; but it has not been driven home to the hearts" (*Luther's Works, Vol. 53*)

Luther understood that there was a need for formal services, yet dreamed of a time when there'd be a need for another kind of experience -- one where people who were serious about their faith could be a part of a community where everyone was deeply involved in practicing the Christian life.

"The new kind of service should be a truly evangelical order and should not be held in a public place for all sorts of people. But those who want to be Christians in earnest and who profess the gospel with hand and mouth should sign their names and meet alone in a house somewhere to pray, to read, to baptize, to receive the sacrament, and to do other Christian works." He dreamed that out of a Christianity aimed at telling people about Jesus would one day come house churches, small groups and other expressions of community that are dedicated to discipleship, deeper conversation and helping one another to speak and practice Christianity. Luther recognized that in his day, such a dream was unrealistic -- its day had not yet come.

Today the question for us is, after 500 years, is it finally time?

Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group Board of Directors Meeting

The Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group Board of Directors met on Thursday, July 5, 2007 at Manchaca UMC. In attendance were:

Bud Broeker called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. The meeting was opened with prayer by Georgia Stone.

Minutes – A motion to approve the minutes from the June 14, 2007 meeting was approved. (Kathy Shaw motion, Mike Rhodes second)

Treasurer – Mike Rhodes presented the current treasurers report as follows:

A motion to accept the treasurer's report was approved. (Georgia Stone motion, Kathy Shaw second)

Board Representative – Kathy Shaw reported that quite a few supplies were received for the agape trailer while it was at Pflugerville and she expects to receive more tonight. We still need song books, dollie, 3 legged stool. It was agreed we will purchase a dollie and Bud will obtain a 3 legged stool.

Kathy has contacted Gene McConnell about setting a date for team selection meeting.

Kathy also gave a report from the Conference Board meeting and some of the highlights/issues discussed were:

- Sponsors need to be sure pilgrims put a second choice for a Walk on their applications, this will save time and effort in case they don't get their first choice;
- Clergy must fill out an application to serve on teams and must be approved by the Conference;
- SWTC has recently revised the bylaws to more closely match the Upper Room model. Kathy has been asked to serve
 on a sub-committee to review the bylaws to be sure nothing was overlooked or omitted. We will need to review our
 bylaws during the coming year; and
- There will be a conference-wide Gathering on April 4-6, 2008 at Mt. Wesley and they would like each Fourth Day Group to volunteer to help with various activities.

Kathy also announced that the Local Lay Director orientation will be held August 11 from 9:00 – 1:00 at Pflugerville First UMC. All lay directors and board reps should attend. Those interested in possibly serving as a lay director in the future are also invited.

Jack Foreman could not attend the meeting but he needs churches to host Gatherings in 2008.

Mike Rhodes has received a scholarship application for the September Men's Walk. It was agreed to award \$90 from the scholarship fund. (Kathy Shaw motion, Georgia Stone second)

Spiritual Director — Georgia Stone has obtained agreements from two clergy to serve as Spiritual Directors for upcoming Walks. Monty Marshall will serve in March with Gene McConnell and Sue Wells will serve with Anne Rioux in May.

Board Member/Member Services – Wayne Roche gave an update on the post card. He hopes they will be mailed out this month. The programmer is finishing up the transfer of data.

Board Member/Walk Support – Tonna Marcyes could not attend the meeting, but it was announced that Jeff Jones will be the new walk agape coordinator.

Other business:

Chrysalis – Candlelight will be this Friday night and closing Saturday.

Tammy Christopher from Houston will be here tonight to give a short talk on Epiphany.

Harlan Kilbourn will work on the kneeling rails but they won't be ready for the September Walk.

There being no further new business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:15, followed by a closing prayer.
