The general format at the web site is a list of instructions at the top of the page, followed by a grid of 6 columns with many rows for the items needed. The list of items is in alphabetical order. If you want to search for a particular item, you can enter <Control-F>, enter the name in the Find box, and press the Next button.

Approximately one week prior to the beginning of a Walk, a reminder e-mail will be sent to you for each item that you have promised to bring. The drop-off locations will be listed in the reminder e-mail.

The weekend candidates, our Brothers in White, are shocked and moved by a selfless love that many of them have never known their whole lives. Jesus has made men wholly new through Kairos. Courage with Faith (Exodus 16:2-4,9-15)

The congregation with the Israelites had some words of complaint about their current situation. "We are hungry!" they said. "You led us out away from what we once knew to a place we have yet to see, with a life and food we know nothing about. In our old life we at least knew that our stomachs would be filled..." They were feeling lost in the wilderness, lost between what was and what would be. What a challenge it can be to follow God's lead, to make changes in our lives, even when the changes are for our own good.

It can help to remember that God was there in the wilderness with the Israelites and God is with us in our wildernesses today: "...they looked toward the wilderness, and the glory of the Lord appeared in the cloud." In the wilderness, we need to trust that God knows where we are.

Ever-present God, remind us that you are with us today. Help us as we walk through the changes and challenges of life by feeding our courage with faith. Amen.

Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group - Board of Directors Meeting **Covenant United Methodist Church** Thursday, August 2, 2012

The following were in attendance: Gary Johnson-Lay Director, Anne Rioux-Asst. Lay Director, Cheryl Broome, Spiritual Director, Debby Duplantis-Treasurer, Jim Burgess-Member Support, Tom Rioux-4th Day Board Representative, Sandy Brooks-Immediate Past Lay Director, Bobby Callison-Walk Support, and Myles McKemie-Gathering Support.

The meeting was called to order at 6:06 PM by Gary Johnson. Cheryl Broome offered the opening prayer. The minutes from the July 2012 BOD meeting were read. Tom Rioux moved to accept the minutes subject to minor changes recommended, and Myles McKemie seconded the motion. The minutes were approved unanimously.

A discussion ensued about exploring possible cooperation between GAE4DG and Hays Praise 4th Day Group to supply walks with walk leadership and/or pilgrims. Sandy Brooks reported that she would follow up with her contacts in the Hays Praise 4DG, and Spiritual Director Cheryl Broome plans to speak to Pastor Dana Hamilton of Wimberley UMC about how we can develop meaningful cooperation.

The Treasurer's report was reviewed. Treasurer Debby Duplantis contacted the members of the conference room team for Walk 1644 to resolve the outstanding fees. Two scholarships were requested for team members for Walk 1686. Myles McKemie moved that the scholarships be awarded subject to accessing the SWTC award first, if available. Gary Johnson seconded and the motion was approved unanimously. A discussion ensued about purchasing worship books and reunion cards. Anne Rioux moved that the Board purchase 100 reunion group cards and 50 worship books (30 books to be sent to Marble Falls which will reimburse us for them). Gary Johnson seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously. Tom Rioux moved that the Treasurer's report be approved, Gary Johnson seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously.

Tom Rioux reported that the Team selection meeting for Walk 1690, February 7-10, 2013 will take place at First UMC in Pflugerville at 7 PM on Friday, August 3, 2012. He reviewed those candidates who have experience and need one more Conference Room Team experience to qualify as future Lay Directors.

Tom Rioux reported on the SWTC Emmaus Board of Directors' meeting held in San Antonio July 21, 2012 and on the Upper Room Leadership Development meeting held in San Antonio July 28, 2012. There were several policy and procedural items reviewed and discussed and it was agreed that the Board would work on those as soon as possible.

Tom Rioux recommended that beginning January 2014, that GAE4DG members wishing to serve on walks should be encouraged to serve on a Servant Team prior to serving on a Conference Room Team. A discussion ensued and the matter was tabled to the next meeting.

Anne Rioux asked what the GAE4DG was doing to advertise the Fall 2012 walks to the community and churches. Myles McKemie said he would request that the persons acting as Points of Contact at member Methodist churches be advised that the Board would fully support an effort to recruit pilgrims between now and September.

Other reports:

Myles McKemie confirmed the following:

- Judy Yemington would be the Fourth Day speaker at the August 2, 2012 Gathering.
- Bethany UMC will host the September 6, 2012 Gathering which will include the commissioning of the team for Walk 1674.

Tarrytown UMC will host the October 4, 2012 Gathering which will include the commissioning of the team for Walk 1686.

Westlake UMC will host the November 1, 2012 Gathering.

Parker Lane UMC will host the December 6, 2012 Gathering.

- First UMC Pflugerville will host the January 3, 2013 Gathering which will include the commissioning of the team for Walk 1690.
- Additional dates for Gatherings for the first half of 2013 are February 14, March 7, April 4, and May 9.

Bobby Callison reported that a question arose about the Upper Room's position on allowing persons who have not attended a Walk to participate in reunion groups. The rule was reviewed and confirmed that a member of a reunion group need not have gone on a walk.

As Kathy Robbins is no longer the Board's Chrysalis Representative, it was agreed that we need to contact the new person and invite him/her to GAE4DG Board meetings.

Sandy Brooks closed the meeting with a prayer.

There were 131 people in attendance at the July 2012 Gathering.
