A word from the Lay Director

Greetings and Happy New Year from your friends at the Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group! We hope your Fourth Days have been great!!!

In reflecting on 2012, we have seen and felt the power of the Holy Spirit working through Emmaus, to change the lives of pilgrims and in helping to build Christ's Church on Earth. Indeed, the Lord has been gracious to the Community by providing the pilgrims and resources to sponsor four Austin-area Walks each year. First of all, we thank God for this opportunity to serve in this way; and second, we are thankful to the Emmaus Community for their support and prayers during the last year.

Now with 2013, as believers we have the opportunity to continue to make disciples and support the Church through our efforts in Emmaus. Although Emmaus is but one way to serve Christ, it is powerful and a genuine way to demonstrate God's love, and to open our eyes to His desire to have a close relationship with each of us. For those called to work for His Kingdom through Emmaus, there is a JOY in being involved in this community sponsored process and to see the cooperation between many churches.

There are four Walks scheduled for 2013; two Men's Walks and two Women's Walks. The first walk is February 7-10 and Christ is counting on us to help make Men's Walk 1690 the best Walk ever! I ask for your prayers for the Team, led by George Tolleson (Lay Director), Monte Marshall (Spiritual Director), Jack Foreman (Board Representative) and Kathy and Ted Shaw (Servant Team Coordinators).

Please note that Walk 1690 needs pilgrims! I ask that you talk up the Walk and encourage potential pilgrims to consider this Walk.

As a reminder, there are many ways to serve Christ through Emmaus. There is the constant need for willing sponsors from the Emmaus community to talk to friends and church members about the Walk to Emmaus, what it meant to them, and to offer to sponsor potential pilgrims for an upcoming Walk. We welcome you to support Emmaus in any way you can, especially by your attendance at monthly Gatherings. Additionally, the public is invited to attend each Welcome Back, a special meeting normally held the Tuesday evening following a Walk where Pilgrims from the Walk describe their 4th Days and get more information about serving on a team, sponsoring Pilgrims; and serving on the Board or a committee.

The general format at the web site is a list of instructions at the top of the page, followed by a grid of 6 columns with many rows for the items needed. The list of items is in alphabetical order. If you want to search for a particular item, you can enter <Control-F>, enter the name in the Find box, and press the Next button.

Approximately one week prior to the beginning of a Walk, a reminder e-mail will be sent to you for each item that you have promised to bring. The drop-off locations will be listed in the reminder e-mail.

Calling for Service on the Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group Board of Directors

So you've been on a Walk, served on a team, attended Gatherings and are part of a regular weekly reunion group. What else could you do to round out your Emmaus experience and be a great resource for the work of our Board?

Consider service on our Board of Directors! We have three slots to fill: Assistant Lay Director, Board Member for Gathering Support, and Spiritual Director. Rev. Cheryl Broome is searching our pool of pastors for candidates to the Spiritual Director position, but she is very open to your ideas about someone to replace her on June 1. You may reach her by email at Cheryl@gae4dg.org

As for the other two positions, there are a few features of Board service to consider. One is that the terms last three years, and another is that we meet once a month at 6 PM wherever the Gatherings are held. Also, if you are on the Board, the Upper Room has deemed you may not serve on a Conference Room Team for a Walk UNLESS you have already been a Lay Director, in which case you may serve as the Board Representative for a Walk.

So, what do these jobs entail?

The Spiritual Director offers advice and counsel to the Board to keep our hearts in keeping with Christ's commands, attends Board meetings, attends Team Selection Committee Meetings, recruits Walk Spiritual Directors, and recruits clergy for Candlelight.

The Assistant Lay Director is there to step in for the Lay Director if needed; takes notes at meetings and compiles the notes into minutes for the next meeting; uses the first year to prepare to be Lay Director in year two, and is the Immediate Past Lay Director in year three. Time commitment for this position is about 6 hours per month including attendance at Board meetings. Our tradition on the GAE4DG Board is to alternate women and men into the position, so we are currently seeking male candidates for June 2013.

The Board Member for Gathering Support maintains contact through emails and phone calls to the Emmaus Points of Contact at member churches to commit to hosting Gatherings during the year, recruiting 4th Day Speakers for Gatherings, and coordinates babysitting for Gatherings. Our practice is to hold four of the Gatherings at the home churches of Lay Directors for Team Commissioning in the month prior to a Walk. We stay about 6-7 months ahead so that the churches have time to prepare for the Gatherings. The time commitment for this position is about 4-6 hours plus attendance at Board meetings.

Please give prayerful consideration to these needs of our 4th Day Group. Ask anyone on the Board and we will affirm what a blessing it is to serve. Our meetings are lively and grace-filled!

Our goal is to present the candidates for service at the April Gathering, so a subcommittee will meet in March (date TBA) to formally nominate candidates for these positions.

Loving Others on our Knees

Christian people pray. Most of us find our spiritual lives gaining the best traction when we think about a world larger than the one we create during our daily life. We pray for the needs and circumstances that ripple through other peoples' lives.

In Christian lingo, we refer to this petitionary practice as intercessory prayer. We intercede for people -- we carry their sadness, distress or fear down the next stretch of the road. Paul speaks of "bearing one another's burdens" (Galations 6;2).

Your worship bulletin may read "Prayers of the People" or simply "Prayers." They reveal the abundance of your congregational heart -- they tell what counts for faith in your church.

I heard someone refer to intercessory prayer as "loving your neighbor on your knees." "Neighbor" in the Christian tradition has never meant only those people we like or whom we can stand. Intercessory prayer deserves to include all people. This is the calling of those who believe in the power of intercessory prayer.

Even when the feelings for other people come naturally, the words don't always follow. When you don't have the words, or the courage, or the sturdiness to pray as you wish, just remember Romans 8:26. The Spirit will stand in for you, if not with speech, then with a good sigh .

Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group Board of Directors' Monthly Meeting Parker Lane United Methodist Church Thursday, December 6, 2012

The following were in attendance: Gary Johnson-Lay Director; Anne Rioux, Assistant Lay Director; Debby Duplantis-Treasurer; Tom Rioux-4th Day Board Representative; Bobby Callison-Board Member for Walk Support; Jim Burgess-Board Member for Member Services; Sandy Brooks, Immediate Past Lay Director; Cheryl Broome, Spiritual Director; and Tim Deschner, Austin Crossroads/Chrysalis/Journeys. The following guests were also in attendance: Gene McConnell, Diane Merwarth, and Jack Foreman.

The meeting was called to order at 5:40 PM by Gary Johnson who opened with prayer.

Gene McConnell filed his report as Board Representative for Walk 1686. He emphasized the importance of the team selection process and careful review of Lay Director candidates and their ability to give the appropriate amount of time to perform the duties of a Lay Director. For the first time in years this walk almost reached the maximum of 36 pilgrims, and the Welcome Back was very well attended.

The minutes for the November 2012 Board meeting were read. Tom Rioux moved to accept the November 2012 BOD meeting minutes, Gary Johnson seconded the motion, and the motion was unanimously approved.

Debby Duplantis presented the Treasurer's Report. Anne Rioux moved to approve the Treasurer's Report, Bobby Callison seconded the motion, and the motion was unanimously approved.

Tom Rioux distributed a calendar of upcoming trainings, walks and proposed walk dates for 2014. He also proposed that the Servant Team Coordinator should handle the Prayer Vigils, Prayer Vigil Report and Community Letters for walks so that these items appear at the proper time during the walk. Tom is looking for volunteers for the team selection meeting (TBA) for the final two 2013 Walks.

Bobby Callison advised he is checking with Ashley Beebe about her availability for child care for the Walk 1690 Candlelight (Lay Director George Tolleson). The Welcome Back for this walk will be held at Pflugerville UMC with a meet and greet at 6:30 PM followed by the meeting at 7 PM in the sanctuary. The Welcome Back for Walk 1707 (Lay Director Susan Curtis) will be held at Berkeley UMC, 2407 Berkeley Ave, Austin, at 6:30 PM on May 7.

Bobby Callison reported that he is researching other options at HEB for Candlelight candles due to the closing of Cokesbury stores. Sandy Brooks suggested looking at the Catholic book stores for them. Bobby also said we may order Walk books for the Book Table from Cokesbury on line and they will offer prepaid shipping.

Jim Burgess stated he has renewed the GAE4DG web address <u>www.austinemmaus.org</u>.

Tom Rioux will develop an email to send to the entire GAE4DG database to update information for the database. Gary Johnson will provide a cover letter for the email.

On behalf of Myles McKemie, it was announced that the April 4, 2013 Gathering will be held at Berkeley UMC for the commissioning of the team for Walk 1707.

Anne Rioux and Cheryl Broome are working on identifying GAE4DG Board candidates for the three-year terms for Assistant Lay Director, Member for Gathering Support and Spiritual Director beginning June 2013. Anne will announce at the December Gathering that she needs volunteers for a subcommittee to meet to nominate these new Board members, and that she needs nominations for the positions. Anyone wishing to participate on the subcommittee or nominate someone for the positions should email Anne at <u>winegoddess99@hotmail.com</u>.

Tim Deschner confirmed there is a Women's Journey scheduled for January 2, 2013 at Buda UMC. Anne Rioux moved to defray some Journey's expenses in the amount of \$200, Gary Johnson seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
