A Word from the Lay Director — Reflections

When did I get so old? Where did these wrinkles come from? These are the questions I ask when I see my reflection in a mirror or in a close-up photograph. No, Mr. DeMille, I am NOT ready for that!

Likewise, reflecting on the year gone by can be shocking. Sometimes the shocks are wonderful – news of a friend getting a job after months of unemployment; the announcement of a niece that she is pregnant again; taking the trip of a lifetime. Others, well, not so much – the loss of a loved one, especially if it's a child; the inability to forgive another's trespass against me; seeing one's health decline.

As we round the turn from 2013 to 2014 and reflect on the events of the past year with respect to our community, holding the mirror up to our "Emmaus life" reflects both our challenges and accomplishments. As we approach 2014 I renew my commitment to work with our amazing Board to "think out of the box" when it comes to how we promote Walks and how we conduct Gatherings. A friend recently talked about "mindfulness" in what we do and say. I would add to that, the quality of truly listening. Thanks to all of you for stepping up and working with us to re-ignite the spark that made us love Emmaus in the first place.

I close with one of my very favorite Scripture verses from 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18: "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."

Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group Board of Directors' Monthly Meeting Parker Lane United Methodist Church, Austin Thursday, December 5, 2013

The following were in attendance: Anne Rioux, Lay Director; Debby Duplantis, Treasurer; Tom Rioux, 4th Day Board Representative; Bobby Callison, Board Member for Walk Support. The following were also in attendance: Ed White, Tonna Marcyes, Roxie Greenway, Paul Draper, and Lois Draper. Because there was not a quorum of voting Board members, all motions were tabled until email votes could be procured.

The meeting was called to order at 6:05 PM by Anne Rioux. Ed White opened with prayer.

The minutes for the November 2013 Board meeting were unavailable.

Debby Duplantis presented the Treasurer's Report. Tom Rioux moved to approve the Treasurer's Report, Bobby Callison seconded the motion, and the motion was unanimously approved by the Board via email.

Tom Rioux moved that Lynn Magee be approved as Board Representative for Walk #1775 (LD Ronee Gilbert). Anne Rioux seconded the motion which was carried unanimously by email vote of the Board.

Tom Rioux also raised the cost of supplying port-a-potties to Walks (currently \$165 for delivery and pick-up of two) as one that is a "hidden expense" to a Walk. He suggested that future Servant Team Coordinators should explain this to the community at Candlelights. Roxie Greenway suggested that future Conference contracts with Camp Young Judaea might include this service, as the access to bathrooms is very limited with respect to keeping the Walks on schedule versus time for bathroom breaks. Although the new conference room in the New Health Center at CYJ is very well-appointed and has good bathroom access, it is too small for use as the Conference Room on Walks. Tom Rioux's motion for asking Lay Directors to get prior approval for using port-a-potties was tabled until the January Board meeting.

Current dates for Gatherings through April 2014 are:

- January 2, St. Mark's UMC
- February 6, Bethany UMC (Walk #1740 Team Commissioning)
- March 6, St. John's UMC
- April 3, Berkeley UMC (Walk #1749 Team Commissioning)

Bobby Callison reported that he has been in discussion with Wimberley UMC about providing child care for Candlelights. He also reported that as of our meeting the Prayer Vigils web page from Conference had not been set up yet.

Walk Reports:

- #1730 Tonna Marcyes and Roxie Greenway reported that they were convinced that it was a combination of the recruiting of pilgrims by all 5 Spiritual Directors for the Walk, as well as the team and community, that made it fill to overflowing.
- #1740 Paul Draper reported that there are 4 pilgrims signed up for the Walk. He is also searching for a Servant Team Coordinator.

Several ideas were made about encouraging sponsorship for all Walks:

- All team members should recruit pilgrims with a co-sponsor handling the weekend duties
- The Lay Directors should write personally to all Austin District/GAE4DG pastors inviting them to encourage members to attend the Walks
- The Lay Directors should ask team members to contact their respective pastors about suggested recruits for pilgrims
- The Lay Directors should be in continuous communication with their teams about pilgrim counts.

The Board agreed to host a city-wide "Emmaus Sunday" on January 26, 2014 for the 2 Spring Walks. Anne Rioux also suggested we have a Board retreat soon and include musicians from our entire list to be part of the retreat. The aim of the retreat will be to discuss 1) details of the 2013 Survey and comments, 2) how to improve attendance at Gatherings and Candlelights, and 3) ways to increase sponsorship.

The meeting was closed with prayer by Roxie Greenway.
